Educate Together Membership	The pupil payment to Educate Together is needed to fund the Patron's national office and must be paid by the school based on pupil numbers attending. As an Educate Together school we depend on the support and advice of the patron to manage the school and to remain part of the Educate Together network.	€10
Voluntary Contribution	Each family is asked for a contribution of €100 per year. This can be paid in one instalment or two instalments of €50 each (in September and January). This is a vital fund for every school and it makes up the shortfall between the Department of Education and Skills grants and what it costs to run a school. Insurance costs have risen dramatically and account for 40% of our capitation grant. Your contributions help support special activities, for example, purchase of new equipment, maintaining our new school building and supporting the learning experience of the children in our school.	€100 per family

Other items:

- **Big school bag with bottle holder at the side (preferable and advisable)** to fit A4 homework pack, change of clothes, lunch bags, bottle of water, etc. (clearly labelled).
- **Drinks Bottle** for water (clearly labelled) that can be refilled in class.
- **Sportswear** - Please ensure your child has a pair of runners and tracksuit bottoms for P.E. Will let you know the day(s) for P.E. in September.
- **Art** - An **oversized old top or art apron** that is easy for your child to put on themselves to keep their clothes clean during painting/messy play (no buttons please). Please label.
- **Clothing** - Please ensure your child has a raincoat (for break-times outside and nature walks) and a change of clothes e.g. underwear, leggings, socks, and top (in a small zip lock bag with child's name on it) in school bag at all times.

- **Sanitising Hand Gel** (reusable container if possible that you can replenish throughout the year-use will be monitored. Please teach your child how to use before first day)
- **Pencil case with twistable crayons** (each one individually labelled with your child's name & kept in school).
- A strong **pencil sharpener** that can fit a wide triangular "hand hugger" pencil & an ordinary pencil (all labelled & kept in school).
- An **eraser** (labelled & kept in school).
- **4 "hand hugger" pencils** for use throughout the year (labelled & kept in school).
- **3 large glue sticks** which should last for the year (labelled & kept in school).
- Child's own pair of **scissors** (labelled & kept in school)

NOTE: The pencil case stays in school on your child's desk and is sent home in June. You will need another glue stick, child's scissors, pencil, twistables, eraser and sharpener for your homework also.

Please label all books, pencils, twistables, water bottles etc to help the teachers and children take care of the children's belongings. Please continue to label clothes as the year progresses as children tend to leave hats, gloves, hoodies etc behind.

Personalised labels can be purchased from mynametags.ie (56 labels from €16.95 - dishwasher & washing machine proof). Sharpie Fabric Markers (approx €10 for 8) are widely available also.
